Progress Energy is also required by Order 890 to post on its OASIS a statement of the process by which the Transmission Provider will amend these rules, standards, and practices that are accessible via OASIS. The Progress Energy OATT is amended in accordance with FERC requirements and procedures for making OATT changes. The Business Practices contain a process for making changes, including providing a notice of proposed changes on OASIS prior to implementing changes. Progress Energy participates in FERC, NERC, SERC, FRCC and NAESB proceedings as a stakeholder, and exercises its voting rights as a sector member where applicable.
